## Artwork Guidelines Checklist

### General Setup, Compatibility & Layout

Artwork is created as either Creative Cloud, Illustrator, or earlier versions Cs2 or later. High resolution PDF's are also acceptable.

**Remember:** We do not recommend that you layout your label in PHOTOSHOP or any other pixel based program. Create your artwork in Illustrator, then use Photoshop for the background image.

Artwork created as CMYK (No RGB)

Only one label per file

Artwork created the exact dimensions that the labels will be printed at.

Dieline on a separate layer and in a color that is not used in the label artwork.

**Ask Us for a Dieline, If You Need One!!!**

Copy, logos and graphic elements that do not bleed are 1/16" away from edge of label. (aka Clear Space)

Minimum of 1/16" bleed used on any graphics that extend past the edge of the label.

Text Extends Beyond  
Clear Space Area

1/16" Bleed Area  
Non-Bleeding Elements  
are within 1/16" of Die Cut

### Lines / Rules

Minimum line thickness is .35pt if positive print

Minimum line thickness is .5pt if negative / reversing

### Fonts and Text

Minimum Positive Copy type size: 4pt

Minimum Reversed Copy type size: 6pt

All screen and printer fonts are included with the artwork. (if file is not outlined / converted to curves)

Convert all Black text under 12PT to 100% Black to ensure it prints cleanly.

It is suggested that all text has been "outlined" (Converted to Curves).

### Colors

All colors are properly identified in the color palette.

Spot colors have specific Pantone Color names.

Special match colors are identified as such.

Make sure Blues do not come out as "Blurple"?

When using a blue in your design, always make sure to leave at least a 30% difference in your Cyan and Magenta values.

### Images

All images are scaled in the source application & placed at 100% in layout.

Rasterized images are at least 300dpi or higher. Bitmapped images are at least 1,200dpi or higher.

### Bar Codes

Within suggested size of 80% - 120%.

Created from a single spot color, in a Vector format, preferably Black.

"Quiet Zones" of 1/8" (no print area to the left & right of the bar code)

### Saving Files

Unnecessary files are deleted.

Hidden elements (i.e. templates, Old Artwork, etc.) are removed from the files.

All linked, placed, or embedded artwork is provided as a separate file, in its native format, and placed in a folder named "Links".

**ALL label text and art has been thoroughly proof read prior to sending in.**
